NATIONAL PILGRIMAGE TO CARFIN Sunday 3rd September 2017



This year's National Pilgrimage, in honour of Our Lady of Fatima, will begin with Holy Mass at 3:00pm, followed by the Rosary Procession at around 5:00pm.

During this year's pilgrimage, the bishops of Scotland will consecrate our nation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

The principal celebrant is His Grace Archbishop Philip Tartaglia of Glasgow.

29-seater coach will leave Jackson Street, Penicuik promptly at 12:30pm and return around 7:00pm - 7:30pm. If required there will be pick-up points at the Roslin Hotel and St Margaret's, Loanhead.

The cost will be £10.00 per adult - children free.

There is a visitor centre where food is available but it is better to take a snack and a flask of tea, coffee or soft drinks. Umbrellas and waterproofs are also advised in case of inclement weather.
