THE POWER OF THREE O'CLOCK

At three o'clock, implore My mercy, especially for sinners; and, if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony. This is the hour of great mercy... In this hour, I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion. (Diary, 1320)

In Jubilee Year 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized Sister Faustina, calling her "the great apostle of Divine Mercy in our time," thereby establishing Divine Mercy Sunday as an official Catholic Feast Day occurring the Sunday after Easter. On this Feast Day Our Lord grants that souls who go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. The exact words from Christ regarding the Feast Day are recorded in St. Faustina's Diary: "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet.... Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy." (Diary 699).
