## WORLD COMMUNICATIONS SUNDAY

Archbishop Philip Tartaglia, President of the Communications Commission of the Bishops Conference of Scotland, has written to all 500 Catholic parishes this weekend (12/13 May) to mark World Communications Day.

This year, Pope Francis has chosen "Truth" as the theme of his Communications Day message and bemoaned the persistent spread of "fake news".

In his letter, based on the Pope's theme, Archbishop Tartaglia writes: "Pope Francis reminds us that Communication is part of God's plan for us, allowing us to express and share all that is true, good and beautiful."

Pope Francis has urged Catholics to: "...contribute to our shared commitment to stemming the spread of fake news and of re-discovering the dignity of journalism and the personal responsibility of journalists to communicate the truth."

Calling on Catholics to be partners in this quest for truth Archbishop Tartaglia says: "Truth is not just a conceptual reality that regards how we judge things, defining them as true or false. Rather truth involves our whole life...it carries with it the sense of support, solidarity and trust. Journalists are called to be protectors of news and to promote the truth"
