Our volunteers will be visiting your parish on the weekend of 21st & 22nd of July 2018.

We will also be selling raffle tickets after all the Masses that weekend. Tickets cost £1 each.

In St. Margaret's Church, please put the textiles in Parish Hall. In the Sacred Heart Church, the textiles will be stored in the garage. At the latest, unwanted clothing can be delivered on Sunday, July 22, in each church before the Mass.

You will also be able to deliver unwanted clothes on a different date or time after making an appointment with Fr. Tadeusz.
