POPE FRANCIS' PRAYER INTENTIONS FOR OCTOBER 2018

Evangelization: **The Mission of Religious**

POPE FRANCIS: PRAY THE ROSARY DAILY FOR CHURCH'S PROTECTION FROM SATAN

Pope Francis has asked all Catholics to pray the rosary daily during the month of October, asking Mary and St. Michael the Archangel to intercede for the protection of the Church in a moment of "spiritual turbulence."

The pope said that recitation of the rosary would invoke Mary's intercession, placing the Church under her "protective mantle."

The statement also encouraged the prayer of Sub Tuum Praesidium: "**We fly to Thy protection, O Holy Mother of God. Do not despise our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O Glorious and Blessed Virgin.**"

Pope Francis also encouraged that Catholics end the rosary with the recitation of the prayer to St. Michael the Archangel, composed by Pope Leo XII: "**Saint Michael Archangel, defend us in battle, be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil; may God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl through the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.**"

Devotions, Rosary and Litany:

There is plenary indulgence for recitation of these in Church, family or pious association.

EMERGENCY APPEAL - INDONESIAN EARTHQUAKES AND TSUNAMI

As you will have seen in the media, the Indonesian island of Sulawesi has suffered a 7.5 magnitude earthquake which was quickly followed by a devastating tsunami. Six-metre-high waves swept through the city of Palu.

Early estimates tell us that over 1,300 people are dead, hundreds more are injured, and many homes, businesses and local services are destroyed. 48,000 people have been left homeless.

SCIAF immediately released £20,000 for Caritas Indonesia's response and we are now appealing for donations to provide life-saving humanitarian aid in the first weeks, and then help people to rebuild their lives and livelihoods. We are strongly encouraging supporters to give generously so that we can help our brothers and sisters in their hour of need.

That said, I know that October is a time when parishes support Missio Scotland, and I do not wish to interfere with this.
