If you wish to have your deceased loved ones enrolled in these Masses, please list their names on the November's Masses reply envelopes and return them to the sacristy. Envelopes are available at the back of the church. Names of your loved ones may be enrolled in the November Masses at any time during October and November. Their names will then be placed on the Altar as we hold them in prayerful remembrance before the Lord and will be mentioned in bidding prayers.

In their memory you may wish to make a contribution to support the Salvatorians in their missionary work. While November focuses us on the deceased, we don't forget the living.

As we pray together for our departed benefactors, relatives and friends, remembering also those who have no one to pray for them, we ask the Lord to continue to watch over and bless us, our families, and our friends.

THE LIVING ROSARY

Could you spare 3/5 minutes a day to pray one decade of Holy Rosary in any place at any time of the day for Our Blessed Mother? (*One decade of Rosary = 1 Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, 1 Glory be...*).

Each person undertakes to pray one decade of the Rosary every day for an intention given by a priest, pondering one mystery, assigned for a whole month and in this way, we pray the whole Holy Rosary every day in the prayer group. "Live Roses" are being organized around the world. It was a devotion deeply cherished by Pope St John Paul II. You will be amazed as to how everything will fall into place once you firmly decide to join in and set the Living Rosary in motion.
