### A MEETING OF ALL EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION (EMHC)

A meeting of all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will be held **on Sunday 26th January 2020 in Sacred Heart Church after 11:00am Mass.**

This meeting is for those parishioners who would like to become EMHC and those who want to continue their service as EMHC.

The purpose of this meeting will be to reactivate EMHC in our new Sacred Heart & St Margaret's parish.

#### Who can become EMHC?

Normally, the parish priest chooses members of the congregation whom he thinks appropriate for this particular role.

To serve as an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, persons must:

- be practicing Catholics, distinguished in their Christian life, faith and morals;
- be at least 18 years old;
- have received the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist;
- demonstrate a deep reverence for and devotion to the holy Eucharist;
- possess the requisite abilities and temperament to carry out their assigned duties
- meet legal requirements.

.Before being commissioned as extraordinary ministers, candidates are strongly encouraged to complete the archdiocesan program of training and formation. This program provides theological and spiritual formation, as well as training in practical and liturgical skills.

**Day for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will be held at Gillis Centre on Saturday, 8 February 2020 from 11:00 - 14:30**

Father Jeremy Milne will be the main speaker and there will be a practical reflection followed by a Q&A session.
