GIFT AID DECLARATION (GAD) - Those who pay taxes are requested to complete GAD Form (GAD Forms are available in the sacristy) and return it to the Parish Office. I'm sure you will like the idea of getting something for nothing. By doing virtually nothing you can help increase the church's collection by 25%, and all courtesy of HM Revenue and Customs. By filling out a simple GAD form and by putting your money in an envelope you will be able to increase by 25% the amount of your money donated to your parish at no cost to you.

If your income is secure and you wish to contribute, **the best option would be to set up a standing order.** If you have online banking you can set this up quickly using the parish sort code and account number (if your circumstances change this can be amended/cancelled).

Mass registration & Covid update.

From Monday 19 July:

As more space is now available in the church as a trial at our both churches, Sacred Heart and St Margaret's, we removed the need for advance booking for Sunday Masses asking parishioners to keep now the new 1M distance from people not from your own family/ household/ bubble.

From next week Communion Service on Sunday at 6:00pm is discontinued, but private adoration will remain.

Church Hymn books can be now freely used and left in the church.

Please note that all other procedures we have in place will remain:

- Face coverings must still be worn inside church, unless exempt.
- Sanitiser should still be used.
