Dear confreres,

It has already been two months since our newly elected Generalate members officially took office on the 137th anniversary of our Society. In this issue of Informationes, you will find details about our celebration and the process of "passing the torch," as well as the appointments of officers of the Generalate made by the Superior General and his Council.

Hopefully the days of Christmas and New Year, with of course Nativity as the titular feast of our Society, have filled all our hearts with joy, courage and hope. We pray that these will be energizing gifts of God's love and kindness, manifested in Jesus, his Son and our Saviour throughout 2019. As it is described in the first Chapter of our Constitution, let us continue to be moved in the spirit of our Founder by the words of the Gospel: "Eternal life is this: to know You, the one true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent." Fr. Francis Jordan gave us the command and mission not to rest content until all people know, love and serve Jesus as their Saviour. At the beginning of this new year, let us encourage one another to grow in the knowledge and love of the Saviour and make Him known to others. On the 2nd of February, we celebrate the Presentation of our Lord. Twenty-two years ago, it was also designated by Saint John Paul II as the World Day for Consecrated Life. May it be a festive occasion, as well as one of commitment, to pray to the Lord for the gift of new vocations. That these seekers will be enflamed to renew the face of the Church and the world by announcing the joy of the Gospel and the love of God which gives meaning to our existence. In this sense, religious life is like a living body which is in continuous need of renewal of new cells, of new blood, and of new air. Let us therefore encourage younger persons by our lifestyle, service, prayer and fraternal sharing, to open their hearts to God's voice and to listen carefully to His call and purpose for them.

In this way, we as Salvatorians, inspired by the Gospel, will be able to make a difference in our world, where so many persons suffer because of injustice, oppression, exclusion or violence; persons without any perspective nor hope. Let us make the difference and go to them who truly need a sign of the Saviour's healing love, a sign of Salvation.

Generalate

Starting the term of office – “Passing of the torch!”

During the week of the 1st of December, the outgoing and incoming Generalate members met together in various intensive sessions for the handing-over. Main items, concerns, developments regarding the Society and its administration were highlighted and discussed. The General Treasurer, Fr. Scott Wallenfelsz, was also present, to provide the new Generalate with needed information regarding finances.

The official “passing of the torch,” was celebrated on the 8th of December, as it was decided by the XIX General Chapter (ordinance 13). On that day, our Superior General, Fr. Milton Zonta, presided at Mass in the Motherhouse, in concelebration with Fr. Adam Teneta, Fr. Ferdinand Lukoa, Fr. Joseph

Rodrigues, Fr. Sunil Thomas and Fr. Agustín Van Baelen, the members of the new General Council and Fr. Scott Wallenfelsz. The members of the outgoing Generalate and the confreres of the Motherhouse also participated in the ritual of transition. The Generalate of the Congregation of the Sisters of the Divine Saviour and the staff members of the administrative support services were also present at the celebration which concluded with a festive lunch, prepared by the Theresian Sisters, who have supported and served the Motherhouse community for many years.

On the following work day, the new Generalate had its first official meetings during which appointments were made. The assignments were immediately communicated to all members by a letter from the Superior General on the 10th of December. Further details can be found in this issue of *Informationes*.

We expressed our gratitude and said our goodbyes to the members of the outgoing Generalate, Frs. Krzysztof Kowalczyk, Raúl Gómez and Thomas Malal, in a special celebration on the 11th of December. On behalf of the entire Society



worldwide, during his homily, our Superior General thanked them heartily for their contribution during the last mandate and wished them God's blessing in their future apostolate.

New Officers of the Generalate

As announced earlier in an official letter on the 10th of December 2018 (Doc AVB18-018), in accordance with the decisions made by the XIX General Chapter and following our Rules Con. 726-29 and GD 7.45-7.51, the Superior General with his Council, has appointed the following confreres as Officers or Secretaries, whose task will be to support the Generalate through their service.

• GENERAL FORMATION SECRETARY

Fr. Krzysztof Gasperowicz is 44 years old and a professed member of the Society for 23 years through the Polish Province. He has attained a Diploma of Psychodynamic

Psychotherapy at the School of Psychodynamic Psychotherapy in Krakow, a master's degree at the *Istituto di Psicologia* of the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome and defended his PhD on "Trust in the structure of Faith in the context of the relationship of Theology and Psychology" in 2018 at the Papal Theological Faculty in Wrocław. Until now, Fr. Krzysztof has been working mainly in the field of initial formation assisting in Bagno, Poland and in Melbourne, Australia. In addition to teaching Psychology in the pastoral field at the Catholic Theological College in Melbourne, he has been working as an Air Force Chaplain in Australia. During his time in Australia, he has been working with our formandi in the Philippines providing psychological tests on a yearly basis.

Fr. Laurent Madiba-Mbambidi is 40 years old and a professed member of the Society for 18 years through the Congo Missionary Pro-Province. In addition to his studies of Philosophy and Theology, he received a master's degree and an aggregation diploma of Canon Law at the Catholic University of Kinshasa, the capital of the DR Congo.

In the Province, Fr. Laurent has been serving as the Provincial Secretary and Archivist from 2012 until 2018. In addition to providing pastoral services in several parishes and schools, Fr. From 2014 until 2018, he was named to the position of First Judge at the ecclesiastical tribunal of the Archdiocese of Lubumbashi.

120 year anniversary celebration of SDS in Romania

On the 17th of November 2018, our confreres in Romania celebrated 120 years of our Salvatorian presence in Temesvar. This community is a part of the Austrian Province. On that special occasion, Fr. Nikolaus Lauš presented the Romanian translation of the Spiritual Diary of Fr. Francis



Jordan. Fr. Marton Gál gave an informative presentation on the history of the Salvatorians in Temesvar with an optimistic perspective of the future. It is worthwhile to mention that our confreres are working on a translation of our Constitution into Romanian, with the hope to be officially recognized by the Government of their country.

Chapters

Ordinary Provincial Chapter of the German Province



After having obtained an indult from the Generalate to postpone the XII Provincial Chapter until the beginning of January 2019, (so it would not coincide with the XIX General Chapter) 19 confreres from the German Province gathered in the historical monastery of Steinfeld to hold at the same time their ordinary and implementation Chapter. Also in attendance were Fr. Agustín Van Baelen representing the Generalate and the Superiors of the Austrian Pro-Province, Fr. Josef Wonisch and the Belgian Province, Fr. Piet Cuijpers. Their presence was once more

a clear sign of the strong desire to think and act together in the framework of the International Society. The Provincial Superior of our Sisters in Germany, Sr. Klara-Maria Breher was present as well. Again, another clear sign of integration and cooperation at the level of the Salvatorian Family. The main ingredients of the meetings were: the reports of the unit, of the communities and of the commissions, along with the implementation of the General Chapter decisions and the elections of the Provincial Superior, his Council and members of the Finance Commission. Fr. Hubert Veesser was re-elected for a third consecutive term of office as the Provincial Superior and his councillors are: Fr. Heribert Kerschgens, Fr. Paul Cyrus, Fr. Friedrich Emde, Fr. Wolfgang Sütterlin and Fr. Lambertus Schildt, who was simultaneously elected as the Provincial Treasurer. The chapter decided that Fr. Michael Overmann will continue as Provincial Secretary for the next term of office, which will start on the 2nd of February 2019.

Implementation Chapters

The XIX General Chapter has decided the following under Ordinance 14: “In accordance with General Directory article 7.22 o, the XIX General Chapter decides that the provincial, pro-provincial and vicariate chapters of implementation are to occur within nine calendar months of the close of this General Chapter, but no later than the 15th of June 2019.”

In response to this Ordinance, the following units have already held their implementation chapter since the last number of *Informationes* was published:

- Austria, from the 27th until the 29th of January 2019;
- Great Britain, from the 8th until the 10th of January 2019.

Other units will hold their implementation chapter in the near future and are requested, if they have not done so yet, to send the information about the dates chosen as soon as possible to the General Secretary (generalate-secretariat@mailsds.org).

Fr. Paschalis (Norbert) Policki SDS from the Polish Province. He was born on the 29th of March 1933, professed his first vows on the 15th of August 1952 and was ordained a priest on the 17th of June 1958. His main apostolate has been parish work in Poland. He died in Mikołów on the 15th of December 2018.

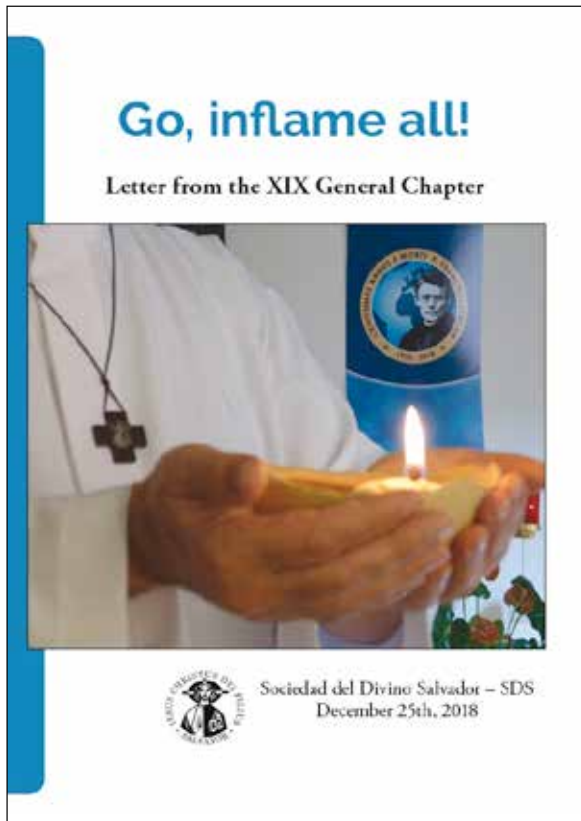

Pastoral Letter



It has become already a tradition that the Superior General at the end of the year writes a pastoral letter to all the confreres and formandi all over the world. This year the focus is on the content and impact of the General Chapter, in order to make all confreres and those who want to join the Society familiar with its most important decisions. The Superior General has also added a short reflection regarding the pilgrimage made at the end of the Chapter in the framework of the first Centenary of the death of our Founder, Fr. Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan.

This letter from the Superior General is meant to inform all our confreres and at the same time provide an instrument to inspire unity and common growth as members of the same Society! We recommend that it be used as a resource during recollections, community meetings and even implementation chapters.

Salvatorian History through revealing letters to Jordan and more...



Briefe machen Geschichte – Korrespondenz der und mit den Salvatorianerinnen; Band I: 1895-1912 [Letters make History – Correspondence of and with the Sisters of the Divine Saviour; Volume I: 1895-1912]. Our General Archivist, Fr. Michael Overmann, together with a dedicated team of Salvatorians and Lay, has transcribed and edited the first compilation of the correspondence between Salvatorian Sisters and primarily with Fr. Francis Jordan, Fr. Bonaventura Lüthen and Fr. Pancratius Pfeiffer, and also with other Salvatorians. The main purpose of this huge effort was to make these letters and postcards accessible to members, so that the stories and facts that emerge from such documents can be placed in their historical context and used for contemporary research and studies. For the latter, the documentation contains a particular benefit in the form of an exhaustive index, sorted by senders and recipients of the correspondence respectively, as well as by keywords, locations and people mentioned therein.
